



Catch Up Plan
September 2020 - July 2021

Funding-Schools are being provided with “Catch up Premium” of £80 per pupil: £14,320 in total

“There is extensive evidence supporting the impact of high quality one to one and small group tuition as a catch-up strategy. To be most effective, creating a three-way relationship between tutor, teacher and pupils is essential, ensuring that tuition is guided by the school, linked to the curriculum and focused on the areas where pupils would most benefit from additional practice or feedback.

Tuition delivered by qualified teachers is likely to have the highest impact.”

At Brewster Avenue we will spend the funding on additional teaching hours to free the DHT to coordinate and deliver this support across the school.

Spring-DHT will be based in year 1 providing a mix of assessment, team teaching and small group intervention to support pupils and teachers. This is likely to have a maths and phonics focus	*50% of this year group returned to school on 1 st June and received targeted teaching in groups of 15 with at least 3 adults. Some children made rapid progress.
