REMOTE LEARNING POLICY

This policy was ratified by the Policies Committee of the Governing Body on: 27th June 2025

Date for review (this policy will be reviewed every three years): Summer 2028

1. Purpose

This policy outlines our approach to remote learning to ensure continuity of education for pupils during periods when in-person attendance is not possible.

2. Aims

- Minimise disruption to learning during school closures.
- Ensure all pupils have access to high-quality, age-appropriate learning.
- Support families in managing home learning effectively.
- Maintain safeguarding, wellbeing, and data protection standards.

3. When Remote Learning Will Be Used

Remote learning will be provided in the event of part or whole closure due to:

- Public health concerns or emergencies.
- Severe weather conditions.
- Other exceptional circumstances.

4. Provision

- Daily learning activities will be shared on Evidence Me, or an email via our management system Arbor.
- Activities will include phonics, literacy, maths, and topic-based learning and will include the full range of learning that would have been covered in class.
- Teachers will provide a mix of recorded videos, online activities, practical tasks and printable resources.
- Learning will be designed to last approximately 2–3 hours per day, in line with DfE guidance.

5. Support for Pupils and Families

- Printed packs will be available for families with limited internet access.
- Teachers will maintain regular contact with families via Evidence Me, email or phone.
- SEND pupils will receive tailored support overseen by the SENCO.

6. Safeguarding and Wellbeing

- All remote interactions will follow the school's safeguarding and online safety policies.
- Staff will monitor pupil engagement and follow up with families as needed.
- Wellbeing check-ins will be scheduled at least weekly.

7. Roles and Responsibilities

• **Teachers**: Plan and deliver remote learning, provide feedback, and maintain contact.

- Parents/Carers: Support children in accessing and completing learning.
- **Pupils**: Engage with learning to the best of their ability.
- **SLT**: Monitor provision and ensure safeguarding and data protection compliance.

8. Review

This policy will be reviewed every 3 years or in response to significant changes in guidance.
