Can you help us keep these memories alive by sending us your photos please?

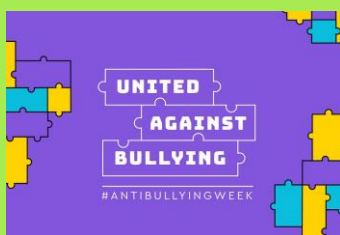
