Child Sexual Abuse

In 2018 The Safeguarding Children Partnership Board ran three surveys on the subject of child sexual abuse, aimed at

- Children and young people (secondary school age)
- Parents / Carers
- Professionals

There was an overwhelming response to the surveys and they were able to share the findings in some national reports. On a local level the results were used to inform the Safeguarding Board's Child Sexual Abuse strategy and training.

The Board are currently reviewing the CSA strategy and resources, and would like to repeat the survey to help inform them where the focus needs to be in terms of training, resources, services etc.
