### Reading record books

Year 1 and 2 parents will be used to their child bringing home a reading record book, that parents and teachers can write in to show when the child has read a book.

We will no longer be using reading record books, so they do not have to be passed between school and home on a daily basis, which will reduce the risk of COVID transmission.

We will be recording an observation on Evidence Me when we listen to your child read in school. These will be share with you via the Evidence Me app.

Many of you successfully used Evidence Me during lockdown to share work with their teachers, so now, you can record when you read at home too!
